

**Curriculum for Advanced Professional M.P.H. Program: Preventive Medicine Track**

The Advanced Professional M.P.H. Program requires a total of 16 course units. Students in the Preventive Medicine Track are required to take the following courses. All “a” courses are offered in the fall term, “b” courses in the spring term, and “c” courses in the summer term.
